Dear Debbie,

In 2010, Bluewater Health completed a \$390 million dollar expansion that brought two local hospitals together, the Sarnia General and St. Joseph's Hospital. We have designed and built a leading-edge hospital from a patient and health care provider point of view. By providing the finest available medical facility, Bluewater Health is better able to attract the best doctors, nurses and health care professionals to Sarnia-Lambton.

Bluewater Health Foundation exists to raise funds for Bluewater Health. These funds are to facilitate the acquisition of leading edge equipment and technology and the provision of education for patients, staff and physicians.

In January 2012 we announced a new two-year, \$2.8 million dollar fundraising campaign to purchase a new Magnetic Resonance Imaging – or MRI – machine for Bluewater Health. Last year, close to 8,000 MRI's took place at Bluewater Health. Our wait time is one of the shortest in the province, however the former MRI was 10 years old, about three years past the average life-expectancy of an MRI. Over the past 10 years, there has been significant growth and improvement with MRI technology. An MRI is the most effective tool we have to diagnose and treat a variety of ailments and diseases. In order to maintain and improve upon our current capabilities, a new MRI machine needed to be purchased.



Fundraising for the new MRI is critical, even more so because these costs are not covered by any government grants or subsidies.

To date we've reached 65% of our goal, with over \$1,800,000.00 in donations and pledges!

A new MRI at Bluewater Health has made a *significant difference* to the residents of Sarnia-Lambton and neighbouring communities. Not only has it meet the area's high demands, the *advanced technology* of the MRI allows for examinations beyond the capabilities of our existing equipment.


